February 27, 1776: Moore's Creek <sup>[12]</sup>

Feb 25, 1781: Haw River

Mar 6, 1781: Wetzell's Mill <sup>[14]</sup>

March 15, 1781: Battle of Guilford Court House <sup>[15]</sup>
