Pushback Comments:

Sometimes, you'll want to respond to something that another commenter has said in a Voicethread presentation. You may agree with something that they've said and want to add more elaboration. You may disagree with something they've said and want to challenge their thinking. These kinds of comments are called push-backs. In a pushback comment, it is important to quote the person who you are responding to so that other viewers will know what has caught your attention. It is also important to elaborate on your point of view and to disagree agreeably! Impolite people are never influential.
